Overview & themes to be covered (5N6D)

Theme 1 - Georgian & Victorian Heritage

London's Georgian terraces and Victorian civic buildings represent centuries of urban ambition — from elegant symmetry and classical proportion to the industrial grandeur of iron, glass, and ornamental brickwork.

- **Natural History Museum (Alfred Waterhouse - Romanesque Terracotta)**

Theme 2 - Brutalism & Post-War Modernism

Post-war London embraced raw concrete and social idealism — producing some of the world's most celebrated (and debated) Brutalist landmarks, alongside pioneering experiments in public housing and cultural infrastructure.

- **Barbican Centre (Chamberlin, Powell & Bon - Concrete Megastructure)**
- **National Theatre (Denys Lasdun - Layered Terraces)**
- **Trellick Tower (Erno Goldfinger - Brutalist Residential Tower)**
- **Robin Hood Gardens (Alison & Peter Smithson - Streets in the Sky)**

Theme 3 - Contemporary London Architecture

21st-century London is a global stage for architectural innovation — bold skyscrapers, adaptive reuse of industrial heritage, and culturally ambitious public buildings that redefine the city's skyline and streetscape.

Culmination & Capstone Project

Participants synthesise their observations into a final design proposal, research paper, or presentation. Projects should reflect on the interplay between Georgian elegance, Brutalist social ambition, and contemporary innovation, demonstrating critical analysis of spatial, material, and environmental strategies encountered during the tour.
